

3 Types of Manufactured Products

In addition to our Natural Stone Products, Everest Stone offers three distinct types of Manufactured Products. Each product has distinct characteristics which make them best suited to a specific application.

Pages 8-13	Engineered Marble (1.6cm Thickness) Engineered Marble is a manufactured product that takes calcium carbonate/powder which is compressed and cut into slab form. The slab then has a heat applied screen print which looks like natural Calacatta Marbles.
Pages 14-19	Large Format Porcelain (1.2cm Thickness) Large Format Porcelain is a manufactured product made in a kiln with a recipe mainly of clay, feldspar, quartz. This product then has a marble look screen print applied. This is the same as any porcelain tile but in a much larger format.
Pages 20-51	Engineered Quartz (2cm & 3cm Thickness) Engineered Quartz is a manufactured product composed of quartz powder, resin, and pigment. These components are then compressed and baked to make a full size slab which is lastly polished. Quartz can have many looks including a basic speckle or calacatta veined look.

Weight: Lighter products are better for wall/fireplace/shower applications.









- Non Porous (Does not stain under normal use)
- Very Hard (Does not scratch under normal use)
- Does not etch
- Uniformity Quartz of the same SKU does not change

Disadvantages:


- Non-UV Stable (cannot be installed outdoors)
- Does not do well with extreme heat. Conditions of extreme heat can burn or melt quartz.
